- Greensboro Gymnastics Invitational requires the FIG Prescribed Competition Uniform for all Judges:

Men – Dark blue jacket, gray pants, light colored shirt with tie;
dark closed-toe shoes

Women – Navy blazer, navy pants or skirt (appropriate length),
white shirt, dark closed-toed shoes.

T & T – Black blazer, black pants or skirt (appropriate length),
white shirt (with tie for men), dark closed-toed shoes.

Judge's Compensation Form

- Upon completion of all judging, please fill out the Judge's Compensation Form and IRS 1099 with the meet referee. All forms should be turned in at the Head Table.
